Library Bird Watch – Stop by the library and pick up a birding checklist to locate our bird pictures hidden throughout the library. There are 15 photos placed throughout the library. Hot Air Balloon Scavenger Hunt – Stop by the library to locate 9 hot air balloons hidden in the children's and junior sections of the library.
